## NORTHEAST-10 OFFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK



**Eddie Vachon, Stonehill (Jr., RB, Newton, Mass.)** - Led Stonehill to a 45-42 victory at NCAA FCS member Wagner as he racked up a career-high 215 all-purpose yards and three touchdowns, marking the Skyhawks first 200-plus all-purpose yard day since 2000. Carried the ball 27 times for a career-best 191 yards and three scores, marking Stonehill's first 150-plus yard day in two years. Scored on runs of 1, 29 and 52 yards. His 52-yard scamper tied the score

at 28-28 as the Skyhawks rallied from a 28-14 second half deficit en route to a 45-28 lead early in the fourth. Returned two kicks and two punts for 14 and ten yards, respectively.

## NORTHEAST-10 DEFENSIVE PLAYER OF THE WEEK



**Steven Good, Stonehill (Jr., DB, Hyannis, Mass.)** - Posted a career-best 16 tackles (seven solo) in the 45-42 victory at NCAA FCS member Wagner on Saturday. Added a tackle for a loss of two yards and had an interception. Pick-off came with 1:26 left in the second quarter, setting up Stonehill's go-ahead touchdown for a 35-28 halftime lead.

## NORTHEAST-10 FRESHMAN OF THE WEEK



**Michael Pierce, Saint Anselm (Fr., QB, Andover, Mass.)** - Pierce set Saint Anselm single-game records for passing yards and total offense as the freshman passed for 374 yards and accounted for 422 yards of total offense in the 41-35 (5OT) win over Plymouth State. Pierce threw for four touchdowns and ran for two more, including the game-winning score from 15 yards out in the fifth overtime period. Pierce was 32-for-53 in the air and also picked up 48 yards on the ground.

## 2009 NORTHEAST-10 FOOTBALL WEEKLY INFORMATION



**AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL:** AIC improved to 2-0 for the season after recording a 58-34 win at Merrimack in a non-conference contest, marking just the 14th time in the programs 73-season history that it is off to a 2-0 start. Junior quarterback Rob Parent completed 21 of 32 passes for 363 yards and four TDs (he added a fifth score on the ground).

He now stands third all-time with 4,833 career passing yards, trailing only Rick Herbert (5,990, 1996-99) and Tom Guy (9,247, 1999-2003). Senior wide receiver Kertis Hussey caught eight passes for 131 yards and three TDs. Freshman running back Jermayne Capdeville carried the ball 21 times for 109 yards and two touchdowns.



**ASSUMPTION:** The 51 points scored by the Greyhounds against Worcester State was the sixth time in their history they have exceeded the half-century mark and the first since 2007 when they scored 71 at Saint Anselm. Junior running back Herbert Woodard (Bridgeton, N.J.) ended with 118 yards,

his seventh career 100-yard game (and second straight this year) one behind the Greyhound record of eight by Fran DeFalco. Woodard's two touchdowns give him 132 career points as he moves into second place with 22 career TDs. Senior linebacker Dustin Zitzmann (Pinellas Park, Fla.) now has 118-204--322 career tackles---fifth on the Hounds' career list. Senior wide receiver David Canney (Templeton, Mass.) now has 101 career receptions for 1,303 yards in his career.



**BENTLEY:** Bentley, following a 43-17 win over Curry College, is off to a 2-0 start for the first time since 2004, the year of the Falcons' last NCAA playoff appearance. Bentley opens its Northeast-10 schedule Friday night at Saint Anselm, and will be looking for its best start since the 2003 team opened with 10 consecutive wins. Junior QB Bryant Johnson (Hopedale, Mass.) is off to a great start, having thrown for

533 yards and six touchdowns while completing 69.8 percent of his passes. Bentley scored 21 points in the final 4:40 of the third quarter Friday, only two points fewer than they scored in the third all of last season. Senior K Tyler McNamara (Medway, Mass.) has moved into a tie for eighth on Bentley's all-time scoring list with 162 points. Senior RB Luis Cotto (Waltham, Mass.) will enter this week's game only seven yards away from reaching 2,000 in all-purpose running. His 1596 career rushing yards ranks ninth in Bentley varsity history.



**MERRIMACK:** Chris Laham (Westwood, Mass.) set the school record with his 24th and 25th career receiving touchdowns against AIC Saturday night. Laham, who has 27 career touchdowns (25 receiving, 2 special teams), needs one more to tie the school record for career touchdowns set by Calvin

Bryant. Merrimack surrendered 58 points to AIC, the most it's allowed since Southern Connecticut scored 62 points on September 23, 2005. The 92 combined points between AIC and Merrimack is the most in a game with two Northeast-10 schools since 2005 when Southern Connecticut and Bryant combined for 112 points. In his first game since moving from running back to defensive back, senior Richard Johnson (Brockton, Mass.) led the Warriors with eight tackles, while returning a kick for 50 yards...Quarterback James Suozzo (Everett, Mass.) rushed for three touchdowns in a 15:02 span in the second half. Sophomore running back Anthony Smalls (Natick, Mass.) totaled 181 total yards (114 rushing, 30 receiving, 37 special teams).



**NEW HAVEN:** New Haven defeated Lincoln University (Pa.) 33-10 on Saturday in the Chargers' first football game since 2003. The game marked the program's return to the gridiron and began a new generation of Charger football. In the win, the Chargers out-gained Lincoln 385 to 193, including a 138 to 71 advantage on the ground. The Chargers totaled 21 first downs and held the Lions to 11. Quarterback Ryan Osiecki went 22-of-33 for 247 yards and a touchdown. The Chargers return to action on Friday, September 11 when they travel to Assumption College at 7 p.m.



**PACE:** The Setters opened their 2009 season with a loss to Salisbury University 34-14. Senior running back Nathaniel Ford led the Setters with 45 rushing yards and a touchdown. Andrew Lipski and Tyrell Zimmerman led the Pace defense with nine

total tackles each. Zimmerman also registered a sack and also forced a fumble. Senior tight end Andrew Kulak totaled four receptions for 67 yards. The Setters continue their 2009 season on the road on Friday night at Southern Connecticut at 7 pm.



**SAINT ANSELM:** Saint Anselm picked up its first win of the 2009 season with a thrilling 41-35, five-over-time victory over Plymouth State that last nearly three and a half hours. Freshman quarterback Michael Pierce set single-game school records for

total offense (422 yards) and passing yards (374) while accounting for six touchdowns (four passing and two rushing). His final TD came on the game's final play, a 15-yard score in the fifth overtime for the victory. Sophomore wideout Marc Wilson, the 2008 NE-10 Freshman of the Year, pulled down 12 receptions for a school-record 187 yards and two touchdowns. He also set the Saint Anselm single-game school record for all-purpose yards with 260. The win was the first home victory for the Saint Anselm senior class. The Hawks travel to Bentley on Friday night for a 7 p.m. start under the lights.



**SOUTHERN CONNECTICUT:** The Owls lost a 19-10 decision to Bryant on Saturday. It marked the fourth straight year that SCSU has played a Football Championship Subdivision opponent. Quarterback Chris Roberts (New Britain, Conn.) completed passes to 11 different receivers in the contest. Andre Privott (Middletown, Conn.) led the way with three receptions for

44 yards and a touchdown. Roberts finished 17-of-29 for 159 yards. SCSU is back in action on Friday for its Northeast-10 opener against Pace.



**STONEHILL:** Stonehill picked up its second-straight win over NCAA FCS member Wagner in as many years with a wild 45-42 victory on Staten Island Saturday. Junior running back Eddie Vachon (Newton, Mass.) led the way with a career-best 215 all-purpose and 191 rushing yards.

The 200-plus all-purpose day is Stonehill's first since Tyrone Jefferson had 236 against UMass Lowell in 2000. The 150-plus yard rushing day is Stonehill's first in nearly two years. The 215 all-purpose yards move Vachon into seventh all-time at Stonehill with 2,294 over his career. His three TDs Saturday were just one shy of the school record. Junior Steven Good (Hyannis, Mass.) had a career-best 16 tackles on Saturday. Sophomore Stephan Neville (Foxborough, Mass.) produced over 100 all-purpose yards, including a 91-yard kickoff return for a touchdown in the second quarter as he finished with 138 yards on three kickoff returns. He also chipped in with four solo tackles, two pass breakups, a forced fumble and interception on defense. Stonehill and Wagner combined for 49 second quarter points (28-21 in favor of Stonehill).

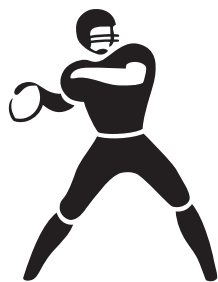
