Weekly Notes:

AMERICAN INTERNATIONAL: The 3-2 victory over sixth-ranked Saint Michael's marked the program's first-ever victory over a nationally ranked opponent.

FRANKLIN PIERCE: Franklin Pierce extended its unbeaten streak in regular season NE-10 matches to 20 (17-0-3), dating back to October 2006, with its two wins last week. The Ravens are also unbeaten over their last 30 (27-0-3) NE-10 regular season matches at Sodexo Field dating back to October 2003. Freshman goalkeeper Vinny Papageorgiou (Wilmington, Mass.) has posted three-straight shutouts and is unscored upon over his last 351:43 dating back to a first half goal from The College of Saint Rose on September 16.
