2009-2010 NORTHEAST-10 MEN'S ICE HOCKEY WEEKLY INFORMATION



ASSUMPTION: Sophomore right wing Pat O'Kane (Hollis, NH/Bishop Guertin), the leading scorer in the Northeast-10 Conference, is the first 20-goal scorer in over a decade as he notched his 20th of the season Saturday in a 6-1 win over Stonehill. The last Greyhound with 20 or more goals in a season was John Ilvonen who had 20 in 1999-00. Twenty-one players have reached the seasonal total since 1979-80. O'Kane is also the first player since Mike Cardillo (25 goals, 24 games) to average better than a goal-a-game since 1997-98. The Ice Dogs are next in action in a non-conference game Tuesday at Salve Regina . The annual Alumni Game is scheduled for this Saturday before the regularly-scheduled game with SNHU. Thirteen members of the Greyhounds earned a spot on the Student Athlete Honor Roll.



FRANKLIN PIERCE: The Ravens dropped a pair of one-goal decisions this week: at Southern New Hampshire on Tuesday and against Plymouth State on Saturday. Freshman forward Roscoe Sweeney collected four points with a goal and three assists at Southern New Hampshire. Franklin Pierce will play each of the next four Saturdays to wrap up the regular season. This week's contest is at Stonehill.



SAINT ANSELM: The Hawks took on two nationally-ranked NESCAC teams this weekend at home in Sullivan Arena. The No. 15 Williams College Ephs were too fast for the Hawks, as they skated to a 6-2 defeat. The Hawks came back hungry on Saturday, as they shut down the No. 6 Middlebury College Panthers 4-0 on alumni weekend. Junior goaltender Alex Wyse earned his first career shutout in the game, to lead the Hawks to their first defeat of the Panthers in 16 years.



SAINT MICHAEL'S: The Purple Knights opened the weekend with a 3-0 loss to Trinity College on Friday night at Cairns Arena, but snapped their seven-game winless streak when they overcame the Wesleyan Cardinals, 3-2, the following afternoon. Saint Michael's will travel to Wellesley, Mass. on Friday to compete against the Babson Beavers at 7 p.m., followed by a Saturday afternoon contest against UMass Boston at 4 p.m.



SOUTHERN NEW HAMPSHIRE: Southern New Hampshire snapped a 10-game winless streak with a 5-4 win over Franklin Pierce Tuesday night. Bobby Bryant (Nashua, N.H.) finished with a pair of goals, including the game-winner, for the Penmen, while Troy Maybury (South Portland, Maine), William Toomey (Reading, Mass.) and Ryan DiBartolomeo (Leominster, Mass.) each added single goals. Anthony Dercole (Hamden, Conn.) had a pair of assists, while Mike Mastracci (Pittsburgh, Pa.) stopped 30 of the 34 shots he faced between the pipes. The Penmen are in action twice this week, traveling to UMass Dartmouth Thursday night and Assumption on Saturday.



STONEHILL: Stonehill, which finished its first semester schedule above .500 for the first time in program history, returned to action for the first time in 43-days with a pair of contests last week. The Skyhawks killed off a streak of 34-straight opponent power plays dating back to a setback to UMass Boston on November 28, before Assumption ended the run in the second period of Saturday night's NE-10 clash. Senior Peter Roundy (Simsbury, Conn.) ranks third among NE-10 leaders with his team-best 12 assists after doling out a pair last week. Stonehill returns home with a pair of games this week, hosting Wentworth on Thursday (7 PM) and Franklin Pierce in a key NE-10 clash on Saturday (2 PM).
